ASPE educates and mentors professional estimators for the sustainability of the construction industry, promotes the lifelong pursuit of excellence and credibility in professional estimating and develops a fellowship of professional estimators that connects and leads the construction industry.

Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be currently enrolled as a full-time student
2. Applicant must major or minor in a construction related field
3. Applicant must be either a second semester college sophomore, junior, or first semester senior
4. Applicant must have a current cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (based on a 4.0 scale)
5. Applicant shall have no relationship with any member of the Scholarship Committee

Application Requirements:

The Applicant is responsible to provide the following information to the ASPE Scholarship Committee.

1. Completed / signed Application Form. (*Form is available at ASPENational.org*)
2. Official transcript of grades for the three most recent semesters
3. Listing of Extracurricular Activities
4. Employment History
5. Completed Essay

Evaluation Criteria:

1. Academic Performance (40%)
2. Extracurricular Activities (20%)
3. Essay (40%)
4. Additional information provided to the Committee, by the Applicant, for evaluation

Award:
